THE BIRTHPLACE

Whether you are expecting your first baby or are adding to your family, we want to help you have the smoothest pregnancy possible. Board certified Ob/Gyns are available to manage your health—and the health of your baby—during your pregnancy and throughout labor and delivery. If you are expecting more than one baby, or are having a baby after 35, your doctor may also ask you to see a Maternal-Fetal Specialist, one of the specialist on staff at Baptist. Maternal-Fetal Specialist work in conjunction with your OB/GYN to provide care for mothers and unborn babies who may

be at higher risk for complications and require a different pattern of monitoring throughout pregnancy.

The Birthplace at Baptist for Women provides a number of services and conveniences to help you prepare, including classes, eLearning, online preadmission and “The Journey of Pregnancy” podcast series. Your baby will be delivered in the comfort and convenience of private Labor-Delivery-Recovery Rooms equipped with up-to-date technology and experienced registered nurses with fetal heart monitoring training. Mother/Baby nurses will provide personalized service for you and your baby in a beautiful and comfortable setting.

Most babies are born without complications for mother or baby. Should difficulties arise, however, you and your baby will have access to the full services of Baptist’s comprehensive medical facilities including a level III B Neonatal Intensive Care Unit, adult critical care units and board certified, experienced physicians in more than 25 specialties and sub-specialties.

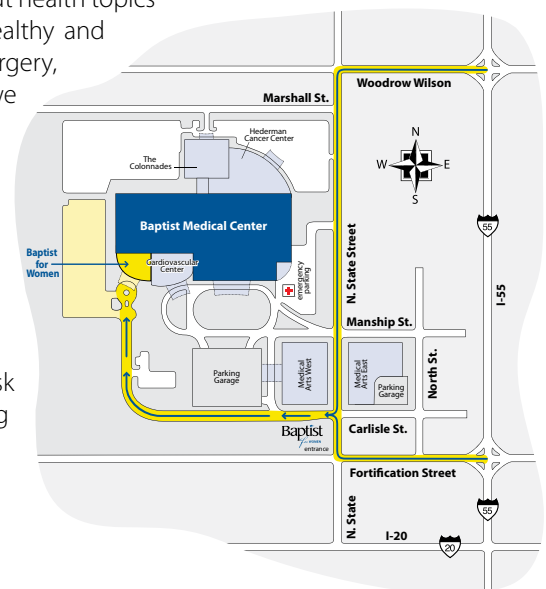
